Code of Ethics and Conduct

on behalf of SAQCC (Corrosion Protection)

I,

in my involvement with SAQCC (Corrosion Protection), shall:

- a) Agree to be bound by the rules, regulations and stipulations of the SAQCC (Corrosion Protection) constitution and by-laws as may be amended from time to time.
- b) Have proper regard to the safety, health and well-being of the public, students and colleagues.
- c) Indemnify and hold harmless the SAQCC (Corrosion Protection) for any and all claims that may be made against me personally for gross misconduct where such claims arise as a result of my association with SAQCC (Corrosion Protection).
- d) Undertake only those assignments for which I am competent.
- e) Protect to the fullest extent possible, consistent with the well-being of the public, students and colleagues, any information given in confidence to me.
- f) Be objective, thorough and factual in any written report, statement or testimony of the work performed and include all relevant or pertinent information in such documents.
- g) Sign only for work I have examined or work over which I have personal knowledge through direct technical control.
- h) Strive to maintain personal proficiency by updating my personal technical knowledge and skills as required to properly practice in my involvement with SAQCC (Corrosion Protection).
- i) Maintain the highest degree of personal integrity and credibility at all times.
- j) At all times act and communicate in the best interests of the SAQCC (Corrosion Protection) Committee and corrosion protection industry.
- k) I acknowledge that should I be in breach of the Code of Ethics and Conduct, that the SAQCC (Corrosion Protection) Committee shall be entitled to hold a disciplinary hearing as per the terms of the constitution as per the disciplinary procedures seen below.

“The Committee may, in its sole discretion, take disciplinary action against any member of the SAQCC or Committee member of the SAQCC to expel them from its ranks provided that such an expulsion was preceded by a written warning addressed to the member and such expulsion is agreed to by two thirds of the Committee. The Committee’s decision will be final”.
